



NATURAL SILVER POLISHING RECIPE:

1 Tablespoon of Table Salt
1 Tablespoon of Bi-carb Soda
Warm Water
Aluminium Foil

INSTRUCTIONS:

Line a small dish or cup with foil (shiny side up) - big enough to hold your piece of jewellery. Mix table salt and bi-carb soda with enough warm water to make a runny paste and cover your piece of jewellery. Leave to soak for a few hours and then rinse. For stubborn grime, use a soft toothbrush to gently scrub away the dirt. Then rinse and you're done! Repeat if necessary for stubborn tarnish.

HINT 1:

Don't leave it more than a couple of hours or the reaction will reverse and your jewellery will turn black!!

HINT 2:

Scale it up for larger silver items such as cutlery or teapots. Use a BBQ foil tray and add equal amount of salt & bi-carb, plus water.

HINT 3:

Don't use this method for pieces with timber elements, use a simple polishing cloth or silver cleaner instead.

HINT 4:

Don't use this method on purposely oxidised (blackened) pieces. It will remove the patina!
